Ten Years that we are still breathing, still walking, still talking and yes even laughing.

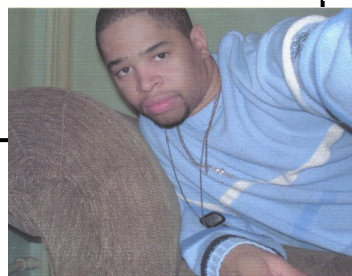
Ten years that we have walked by a basketball court unable to bear the sights and sounds of the bouncing ball. but yet peeking to see the new athletes of tomorrow.
